TERM ONE

TERM TWO

- Finalise your fundraising activities. Get creative there are lots of ideas in the Pink Shirt Day toolkits.
- Create your online fundraising page through the Pink Shirt Day website. This is the simplest way to collect donations to support our bullying elimination efforts.
- Promote your Pink Shirt Day activities on your social media networks and school newsletters.
